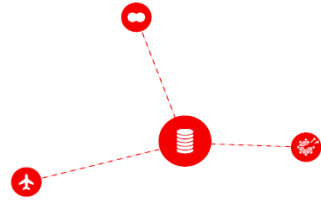

Strywythur Structure



- **Pathway 1 – Mobility of participants**

Projects deliver **physical, virtual and blended outward and inward mobility** of individuals or groups, providing flexible short- and long-term opportunities to learn, study, work or volunteer abroad.

- **Pathway 2 – Partnership and strategic collaboration**

International collaborative projects led by education and training organisations in Wales to develop enhancement-led international learning exchange activities and practices.

- **Pathway 3 – Capacity building**

Supports the **capacity-building for international exchanges**, to develop structures, knowledge base, experience and staffing to grow international education activities and increase learning exchanges.

Trosolwg Llwybr 1 Addysg Oedolion / Pathway 1 Adult Education Overview

- The total indicative budget available to eligible organisations under the Pathway **1 – Adult Education Mobility 2022 call is £0.2 million.**
- The deadline to submit an application to **Pathway 1 – Adult Education is 12:00 (noon) on 12 May 2022.** Applications received after this deadline will not be assessed.
- Pathway 1 will fund the **mobility of learners** (outward and inward mobility of learners studying at educational or training providers)
- And **mobility of staff**
- Opportunities for **12 months** or **24 months** projects in 2022 call.

Gweithgareddau cymwys / *eligible activities*

1. Group mobilities

Mobilites for learners which are led by adult education organisations and facilitate group activities – formal, non-formal and informal learning and training opportunities. Staff from the applying organization may accompany the learners and guide the learning process.

Tuition fee waivers required (where appropriate).

- Minimum 3 days – maximum 1 month

Contribution to costs: Travel, subsistence, additional contributions for ALN and disadvantaged participants + organisational support

2. Blended group mobilities

A mixture of a virtual experience combined with a physical international mobility in partnership with an international partner. Blended programmes aim to complement physical mobility abroad and can help build confidence amongst those who have not been abroad.

- Minimum 3 days and 20 hours of virtual engagement – maximum 2 weeks physical mobility and no limit for virtual hours.

Contribution to costs: Travel, subsistence, additional contributions for ALN and disadvantaged participants + organizational support

Gweithgareddau cymwys / *eligible activities*

3. Individual mobilities

Bespoke opportunities for individual learners to undertake a period of international learning exchange independently. Staff would not normally accompany the learner(s)

Tuition fee waivers required (where appropriate).

- Minimum 2 weeks – maximum 12 months

Contribution to costs: Travel, subsistence, additional contributions for ALN and disadvantaged participants + organisational support

4. Virtual group exchanges

Virtual exchanges where physical mobility or travel would otherwise not be possible / feasible.

- Minimum of 35 hours of virtual engagement.

Contribution to costs: developing and delivering a high-quality virtual exchange, including a contribution to course fees for a third-party provider. Organisational support for up to 20 participants.

Gweithgareddau cymwys (staff) / eligible activities (staff)

1. Datblygu Proffesiynol / Professional Development

Mobilites to collaborate with colleague at a partner organisation to offer training or facilitation activities, knowledge exchange or identifying best practice and professional development and broadening knowledge.

- Minimum 2 days – maximum 1 month

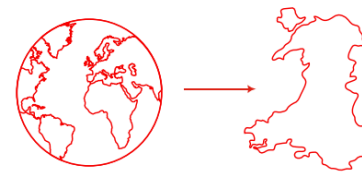
Contribution to costs: Travel, subsistence, additional contributions for ALN and disadvantaged participants, course fees + organisational support (conference fees excluded)

2. Ymweliadau paratoadol / Preparatory visits

Funding for staff to spend time at a potential partner for initial discussions, review of facilities and support structures for learners and collaborating on planning.

- Minimum 2 days– maximum 1 week.

Contribution to costs: Travel, subsistence, additional contributions for ALN and disadvantaged participants. (organisational support excluded)

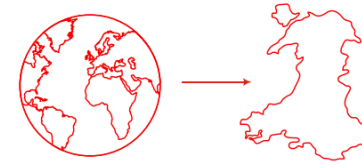

Inward Mobility

- Bydd Taith yn cynnig yr opsiwn i sefydliadau ofyn am gyllid ychwanegol ar ben y cyllid ar gyfer symudedd allanol **er mwyn ariannu symudedd mewnol i Gymru.**
- Wrth baratoi'r cais, gall sefydliadau ofyn am **30%** (wedi ei gyfrifo fel canran o'r cyfanswm a briodolir ar gyfer symudedd allanol, a fydd yn cael ei dalu ar ben y grant symudedd allanol), er mwyn ariannu symudedd mewnol i Gymru.
- Taith will offer the option for the applying organisations to request additional grant funding, on top of their outward mobilities project grant, to be utilised solely **for the purposes of funding inward mobility to Wales.**
- At the application stage, an applying organisation can request any amount up to **30%** (calculated as a percentage of the total amount awarded for outward mobility and paid on top of the grant for outward mobility), in order to fund inward mobility to Wales.

Mobilities from International partners to Wales
(Inbound to Wales)

- **'Cyfraniad Taith tuag at gostau symudedd'**, a delir gan y buddianwyr o Gymru i gyfranogwyr o dramor fel ad-daliad am dreuliau neu fel taliad uniongyrchol am dreuliau lleol, gan gynnwys taliad am ar gyfer cynhaliaeth ddyddiol.
- **'Taith contribution to the costs of mobility'**, paid by the Welsh beneficiary directly to inward participants as a reimbursement for costs incurred, or as a direct payment for local costs incurred, including a stipend payment as a contribution towards daily subsistence.
