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

Main task:

Providing complex support for complex economic and social problems (especially for life situations complicated by accumulated disadvantages)

- Developing toolkits for opportunity creation
- Promoting equal opportunities and compensating for social disadvantages for children and young people
- Helping disadvantaged adults to catch up
- Providing professional support for the implementation of territorial programs in order to facilitate territorial catchingup
- Facilitate the adoption of catch-up model programs in Hungarian-inhabited areas across the border
- Performing tasks related to the tendering and financing of the Sure Start Children's Homes and "Tanoda" program
- Performing tasks related to the long-term program of "Catching up Settlements"

"The **creation of rules** for adult education to help catch up in order to **design, implement** and **control complex development**."


